

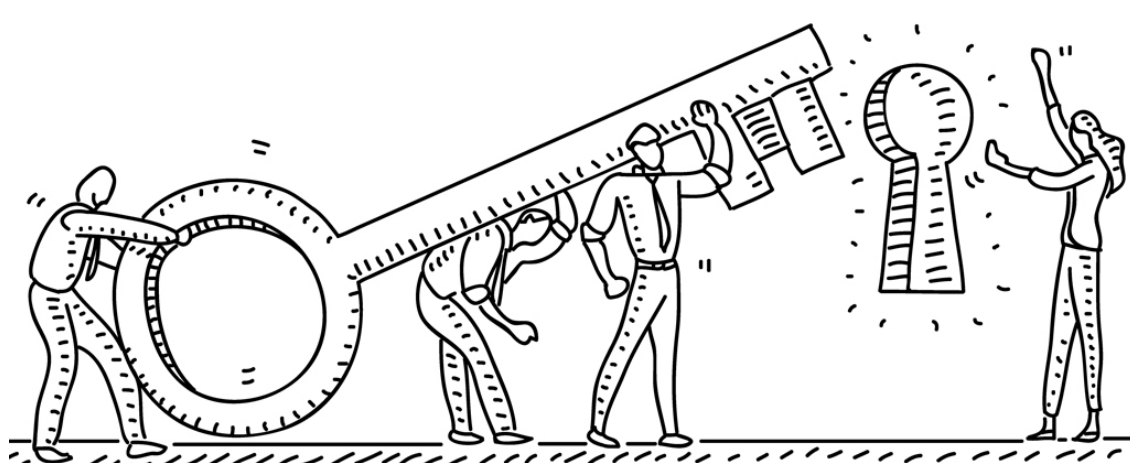
Dear Friend,

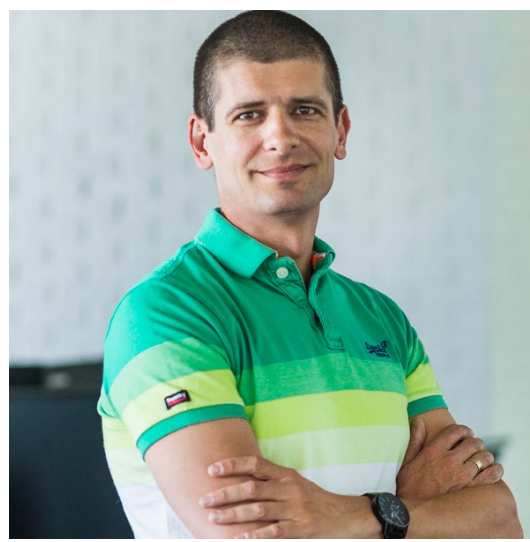
